

# College Lacrosse Recruiting Process

This process requires you to do the work and find a good fit athletically and academically, not your parents or your coaches. Parents and coaches should be used as a resource but should not be doing the emailing and calling of college coaches. If you have any questions please give me a call and I can clarify or walk through this process with you in more detail.

1. Complete and submit the online Prospective Student-Athlete Questionnaire for interested schools.
2. Most importantly, have your HS Coach/Club Coach **contact college** about your athletic/lacrosse abilities and character.
3. Send a recent DVD, preferably a highlight tape-followed by a game, of you playing lacrosse to college coaches. Many prefer hard copies DVD over online video.
4. Send a copy of your high school transcript (asap) and your SAT/ACT test results when you receive them to the schools you have been in contact with.
5. Send a fall lacrosse schedule if you are playing. If you want a guarantee that coaches will see you, I would highly recommend you attend an overnight lacrosse camp in the summer or a showcase in the fall for the school your interested in.
